

Pumpkinfest 2026 Vendor Rules and Regulations

All vendors who wish to participate **MUST** fill out an application form, including a complete list of ALL items you wish to sell. (Excludes soft drinks.) The completed application form and payment **MUST** be returned by September 1, 2026. All items submitted for sale must be approved by the committee. You will be notified if any items are not approved.

Your canceled check will be your receipt and notification of approval.

EVENT POLICIES FOR COMMERCIAL VENDORS

Each \$400.00 entitles the vendor to one 10ft. x 30ft. space with electricity for the 3-day festival. Additional 10ft.x10ft. space is \$100.00. You must specify the amperage service you need on your application. (Max 50 amp, 240 Volt)

ELECTRIC OPTIONS FOR SMALL VENDORS

Each \$135.00 entitles the vendor to one 10ft. x 10ft space for the 3-day festival. There is an additional \$10.00 fee for electrical service. (One 20 amperage receptacle with 2 plug-ins.) If additional electricity is needed, please specify your requirement on the application and we will do our best to accommodate. If unable to provide additional electricity, we will notify you in advance and refund your electrical fee.

ADDITIONAL EVENT POLICIES FOR ALL VENDORS

Food vendors are **NOT** permitted to sell hamburgers, hot dogs, shoestring fries, pumpkin pies or Pepsi Products. No exceptions!

Spaces will be assigned randomly to all registrants. Please provide an email address on the application. We will try to place the previous year's vendors in the same locations, but we cannot guarantee this. **Booth set up will start at 6:00pm on the Thursday before the festival.**

All vendors are expected to be open on Friday from 2:00pm to 9:00pm, Saturday from 9:00am to 9:00pm, and Sunday from 9:00am to 6:00pm. We ask that you do not tear down before 6:00pm on Sunday, unless you run out of merchandise, receive special permission from the committee, OR if you are participating in the parade. Please let the committee know if any of these circumstances pertain to you.

Please make prior arrangements with the Pumpkinfest committee if electricity is needed on Thursday. There will be an additional \$10.00 fee. Otherwise, electricity will **NOT** be available until Friday.

Heavy duty electrical cords and power strips are required for all vendor booths. (Trailers, canopies, tents, etc.)

Electric heaters are **NOT** permitted.

Absolutely **NO** vehicles will be permitted on festival grounds after 12:00pm on Friday.

All vendors **MUST** provide their own tables, chairs, and garbage cans with bags for their

space. Garbage will be picked up periodically throughout each day of the festival. All cardboard boxes must be flattened and placed in dumpsters.

All vendors should prepare for inclement weather. We ask that all canopies, tents, and trailers are secure.

Vendors are NOT permitted to use the logo or name of Pumpkinfest OR the logo or name of “Confluence – Where Mountains Touch Rivers.” You must receive written permission from the Pumpkinfest Committee prior to the festival if you would like to use these logos.

Vendors are NOT permitted to sell tasers, smoke bombs, stink bombs, spray paint, spray foam, any kind of guns (this includes toy guns), knives, projectiles, satanic items, or drug related paraphernalia.

Absolutely NO pets, roller blades, skates, skateboards, or bikes will be permitted on festival grounds.

ALCOHOL OF ANY KIND IS PROHIBITED!

Overnight security will be provided for Friday and Saturday nights from 10:00pm to 6:00am. The Pumpkinfest Committee is NOT responsible for fire or theft of any vendor items while on festival grounds.

Gray water may only be dumped in the proper locations. See a committee member for assistance. By signing the application form, you agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Pumpkinfest Committee. Failure to do so will result in immediate expulsion from festival grounds and legal action may be taken against you.

Application forms and payment must be received by September 1, 2026. First Come, First Served. We accept checks or money orders. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.

**Once your check has cleared, consider your application approved.
When you arrive to set up, only then will you be given the location of your spot.
You can go to the Information Booth or see a Fireman and they will direct you.**
